The current wave of COVID-19 seems to be clustered in the Southeast and parts of the Midwest. Influenza is on the dramatic rise. Bacterial Co-infection rates remain moderate among viral positive patients ranging from ~32-50% depending on the viral pathogen detected. Nearly 1/2 of all viral positive patients will also test positive for Staphylococcus A. and/or Haemophilus influenza.
